

KWAKEWLTH INDIAN AGENCY
CAMPBELL RIVER BAND BYLAWS

The council of the Campbell River Band of Indians at a meeting held makes the following by law pursuant to paragraph (1) and (r) of section 80 of the Indian Act:

Bylaw No. 1

A bylaw to provide for the regulation of the use of public wells, cisterns, reservoirs and other water supplies.

- (a) No person shall wilfully or maliciously pollute any public well, cisterns, reservoir or other water supply within the Campbell River Indian Reserve, in the Province of British Columbia.
- (b) No person shall destroy or injure any public well, cistern, reservoirs or other water supply within the reserve.
- (c) The holder of a certificate of possession or occupant of land within the reserve shall keep any well thereon properly enclosed or covered.
- (d) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding ten dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding seven days, or both fine and imprisonment.
