

KWAKEWLTH INDIAN AGENCY
CAMPBELL RIVER BAND BYLAWS

The Council of the Campbell River Band of Indians at the meeting held on January 8, 1955 makes the following bylaw pursuant to paragraph (g) and (r) of section 80 of the Indian Act:

Bylaw No.6:

A bylaw to provide for the dividing of the Reserve or a portion thereof into zoned and the prohibition of the construction or maintenance of any class of buildings or the carrying on of any class of business, trade or calling in such zone.

- (a) "No building shall be erected for the purpose of conducting a business of any kind within the reserve without permission first having been granted by the Council for the construction of said building or the conduct of a business."
- (b) No business of any kind may be established on the Campbell River Reserve 1 unless authorized by Council.
- (c) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding ten dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding seven days or both fine and imprisonment.
