Duties & Responsibilities

- Interact with children to create a safe, healthy, and happy learning environment that supports their emotional, social, cognitive, and physical development.
- Plan, implement, and evaluate age-appropriate programs and activities that foster growth in language, motor skills, creativity, and socialization.
- Observe and document children's progress, behavior, and developmental milestones to support individualized learning plans and communicate effectively with families.
- Collaborate with the Pre-School Supervisor in assessing each child's needs and contributing to the implementation of the care and learning program.
- Establish and maintain positive, respectful relationships with children, parents, families, colleagues, and community partners, contributing to a supportive and inclusive environment.

- Maintain confidentiality and professionalism at all times.

- Support the effective operation of the Pre-School by performing duties as assigned by the Supervisor and relieving the Supervisor as required.
- Participate in ongoing professional development and collaborate with other professionals to continuously improve the quality of care and education.
